### Notice of Annual General Meeting – January 31, 2007

**Toronto, ON: November 17, 2006:** The AGM will take place on the opening day of the Ontario Library Association Superconference 2007 in room 206E.

**The Annual General Meeting of the Federation of Ontario Public Libraries will take place  
Wednesday, January 31, 2007 - 4:30 p.m.  
at the Metro Toronto Convention Centre, Toronto  
Room 206E**

Resolutions shall be prepared and submitted to the Board no later than January 10th. Resolutions, other than resolutions proposed by the Board, may not exceed 200 words in length, and shall be signed by the presiding officer and the secretary of the submitting body. Members, Associate Members, and the Board may submit resolutions to the Annual General Meeting.

Emergency resolutions shall have the same requirements as regular resolutions, respective of word length and signatories. Emergency resolutions may be presented to the Annual General Meeting where the matter provoking the resolution could not reasonably have been known by the submitting body more than 30 days prior to the Annual General Meeting, subject to the approval of the Board.

Members or Associate Members shall be required to have paid applicable annual membership fees for 2007 to be eligible to attend the Annual General Meeting of the Federation.
